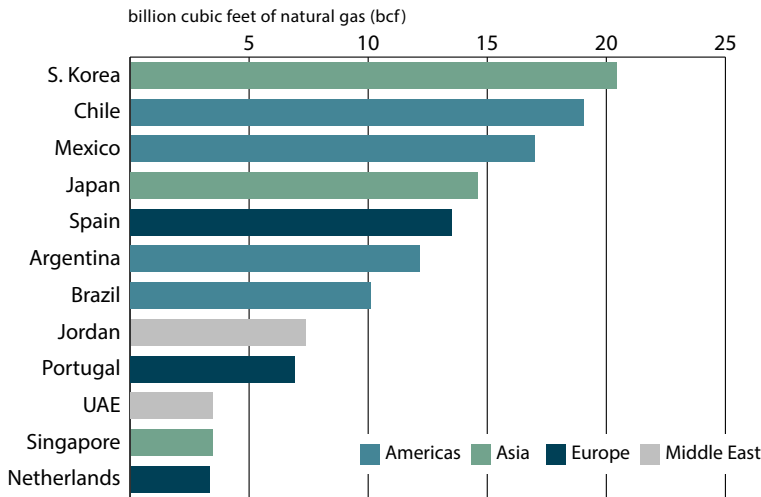


U.S. LNG Exports: June 2019

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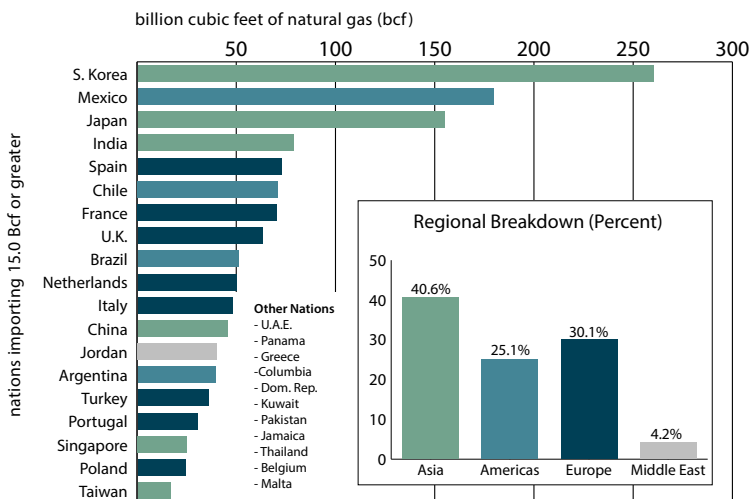
MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (JUNE)

- Western Hemisphere overtakes Asia as top importing region for U.S. LNG shipments.
- Freeport LNG (Texas) and Elba Island (Georgia) continue commissioning activities (first cargoes in Q3 2019).

TOP 5 DESTINATIONS (JUNE)

- So. Korea, 20.2 bcf
- Chile, 19.0 bcf
- Mexico, 17.0 bcf
- Japan, 14.6 bcf
- Spain, 13.5 bcf
- Others: Argentina, Brazil, Jordan, Portugal, U.A.E., Singapore, Netherlands, Panama, India, Italy, Dominican Republic

- Americas, 62.6 bcf (44.1%)
- Asia, 41.6 bcf (29.4%)
- Europe, 26.8 bcf (18.9%)
- Middle East, 10.8 bcf (7.6%)

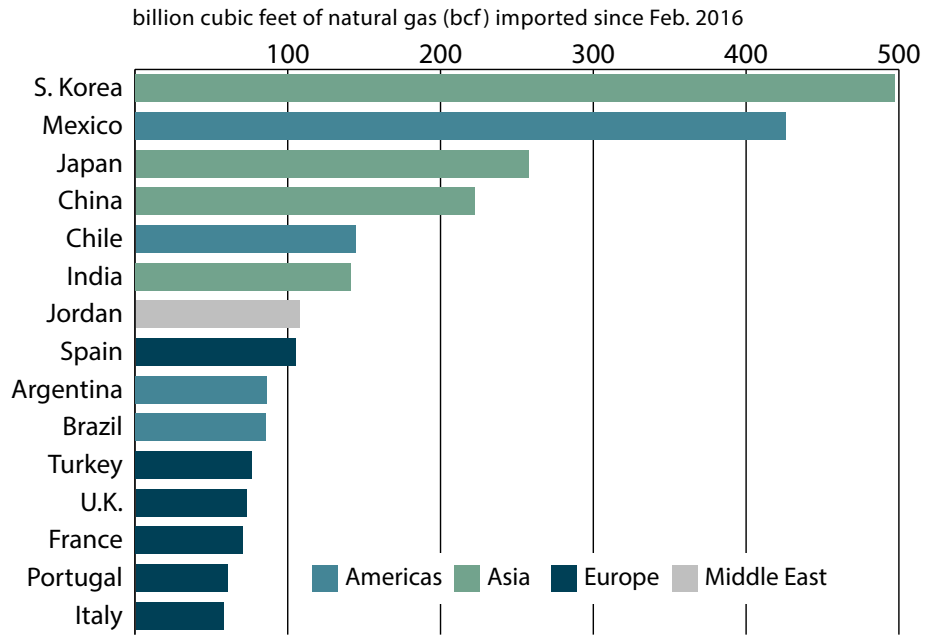
VOLUME EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- Total exports of 141.8 bcf
- 2.1% less than May 2019
- 93.0% more than June 2018

CARGOES EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- 47 Cargoes from 4 Terminals
- 31 - Sabine Pass (-2 from May)
- 8 - Corpus Christi (+1)
- 7 - Cove Point (+2)
- 1 - Cameron (same as May)

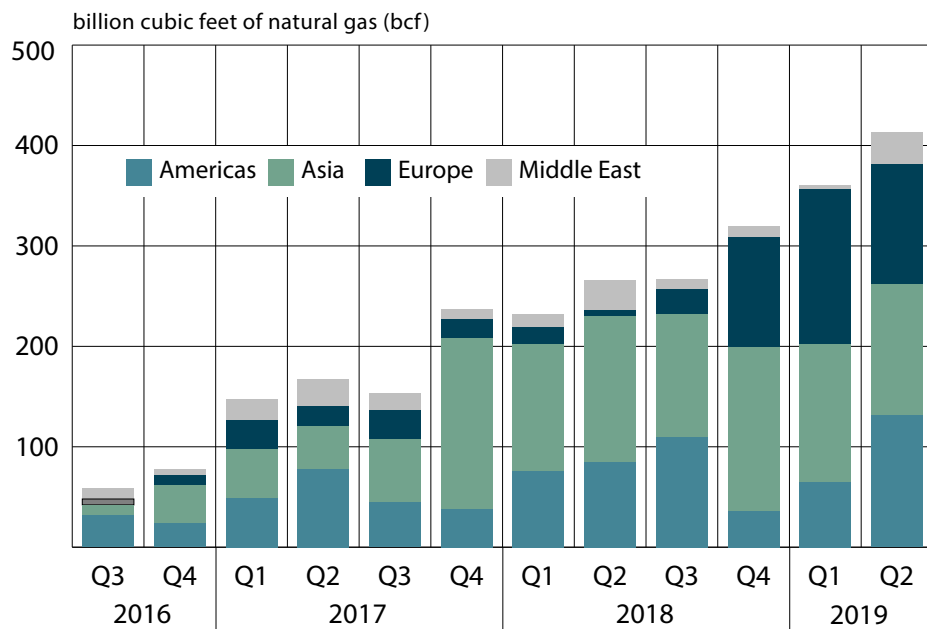
Top 15 Importers of U.S. LNG - Since Feb. 2016
