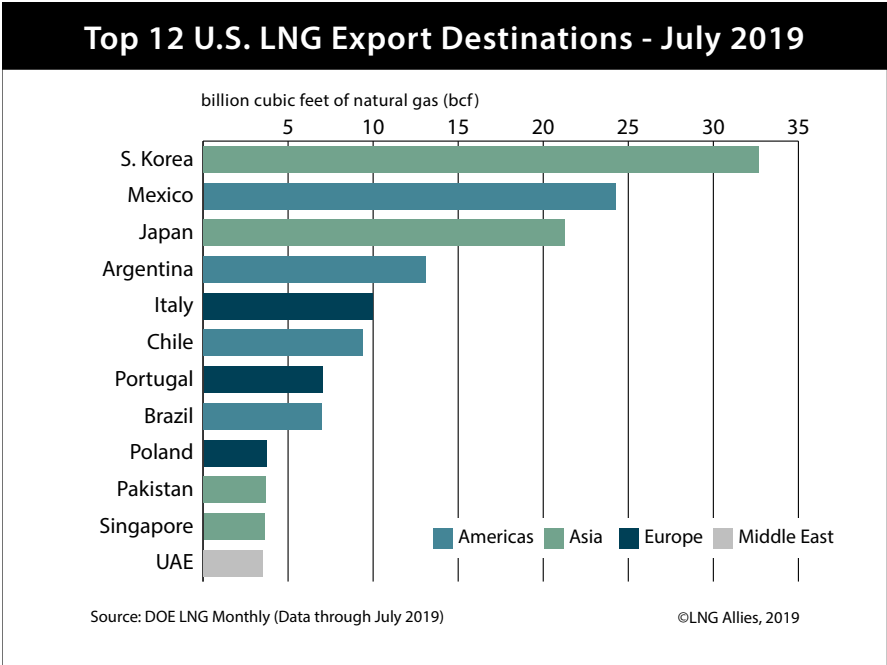


U.S. LNG Exports: July 2019



MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (JULY)

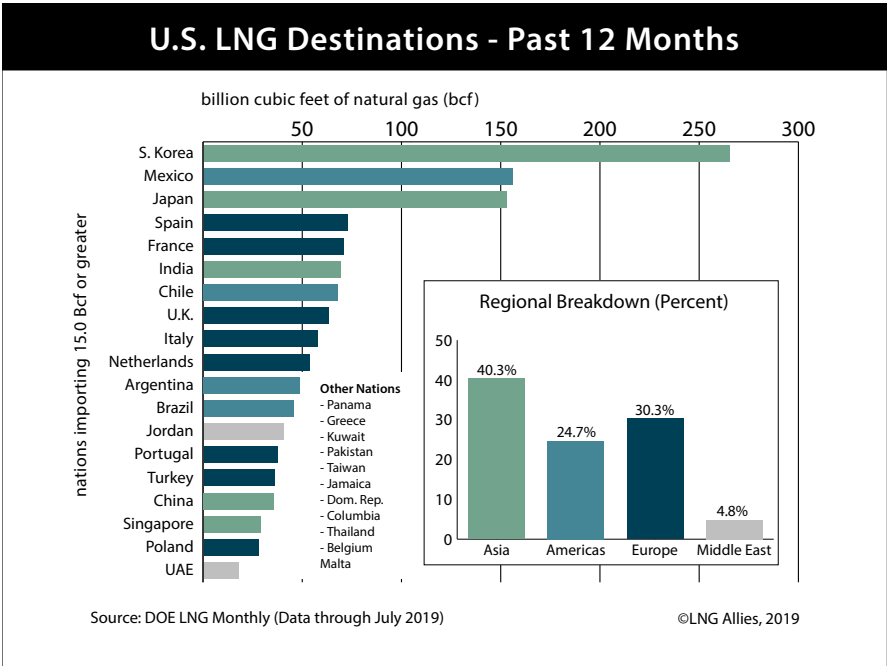
- Asia overtakes Western Hemisphere as top importing region for U.S. LNG shipments.

TOP 5 DESTINATIONS (JULY)

- So. Korea, 32.7 bcf
- Mexico, 24.2 bcf
- Japan, 21.2 bcf
- Argentina, 13.1 bcf
- Italy, 10.0 bcf
- Others: Chile, Portugal, Brazil, Poland, Pakistan, Singapore, UAE, India, Jordan, Kuwait, Netherlands, Spain, Jamaica

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN (JULY)

- Americas, 54.4 bcf (34.7%)
- Asia, 64.6 bcf (41.2%)
- Europe, 27.3 bcf (17.4%)
- Middle East, 10.3 bcf (6.6%)



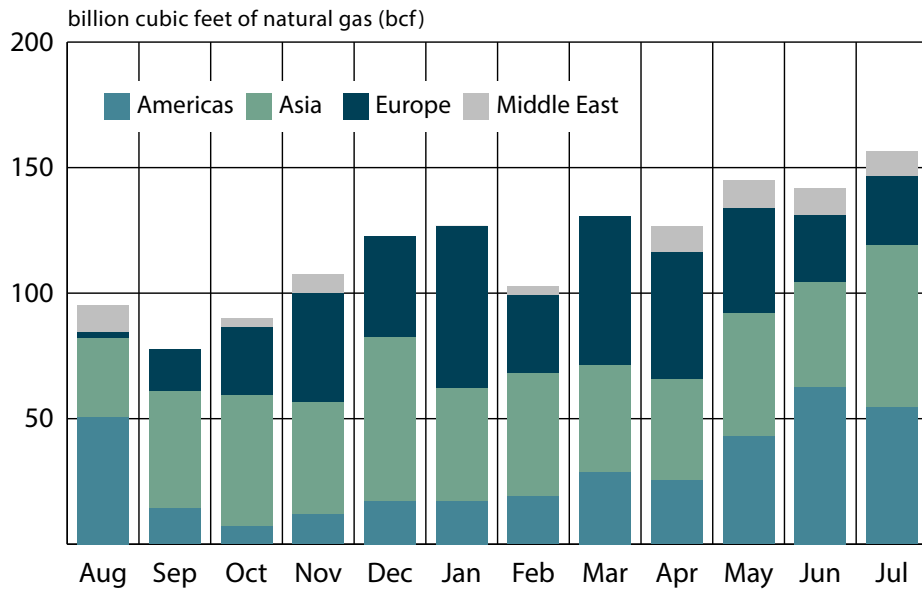
VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- Total exports of 157.6 bcf
- 10.5% more than June 2019
- 59.6% more than July 2018

CARGOES EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- 51 Cargoes from 4 Terminals
- 32 - Sabine Pass (+1 from June)
- 10 - Corpus Christi (+2)
- 7 - Cove Point (unchanged)
- 2 - Cameron (+1)

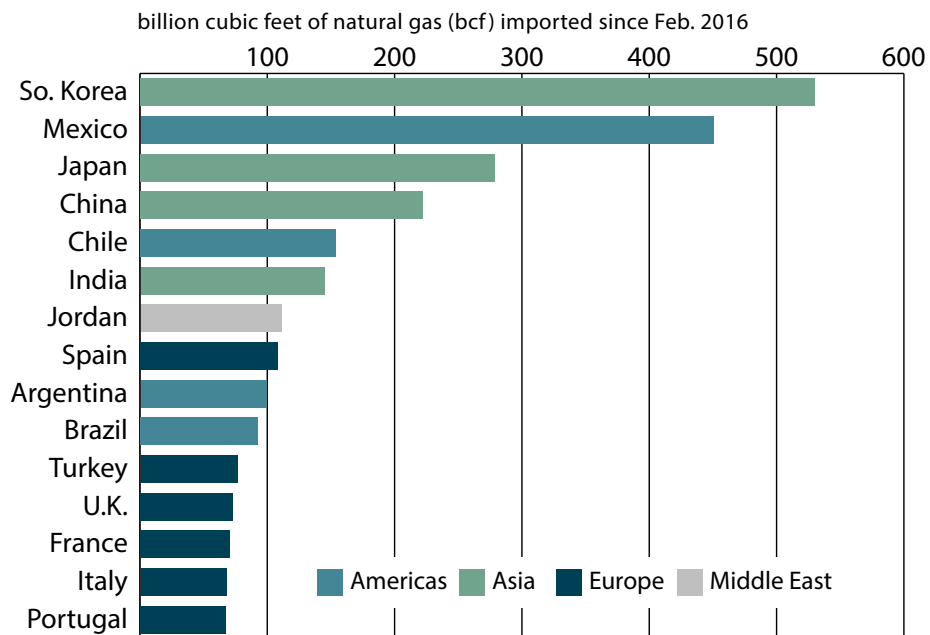
Regional Distribution of U.S. LNG - Past 12 Months
