

U.S. LNG Exports: Oct. 2019

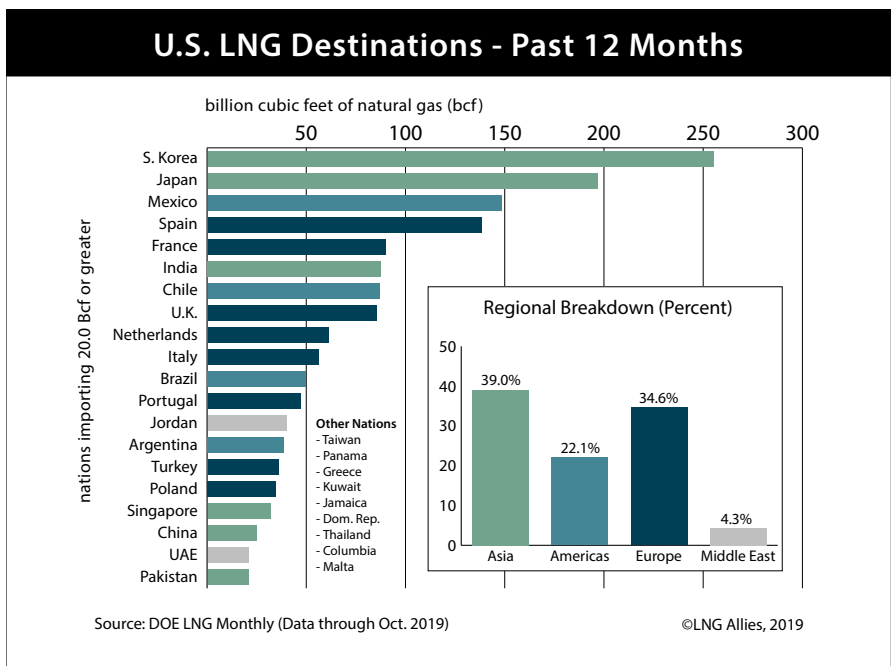


MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (OCT.)

- U.S. LNG export volumes/cargoes set another record. Asia becomes top market again; Europe a close second. Record volumes to United Kingdom. Freeport continues to ramp up production.

- Middle East, 0 bcf (0%)

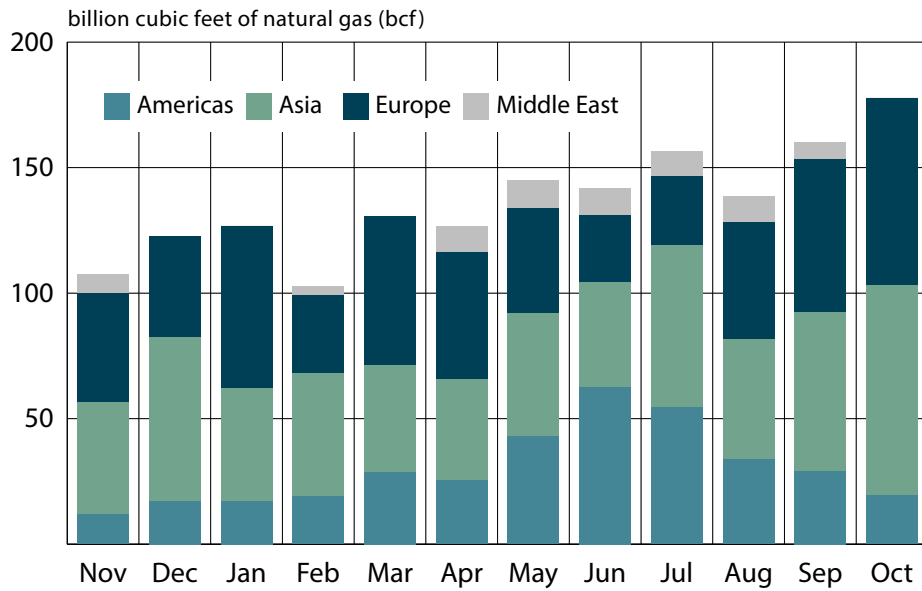
VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- 2 - Cove Point (-2 from Aug.)

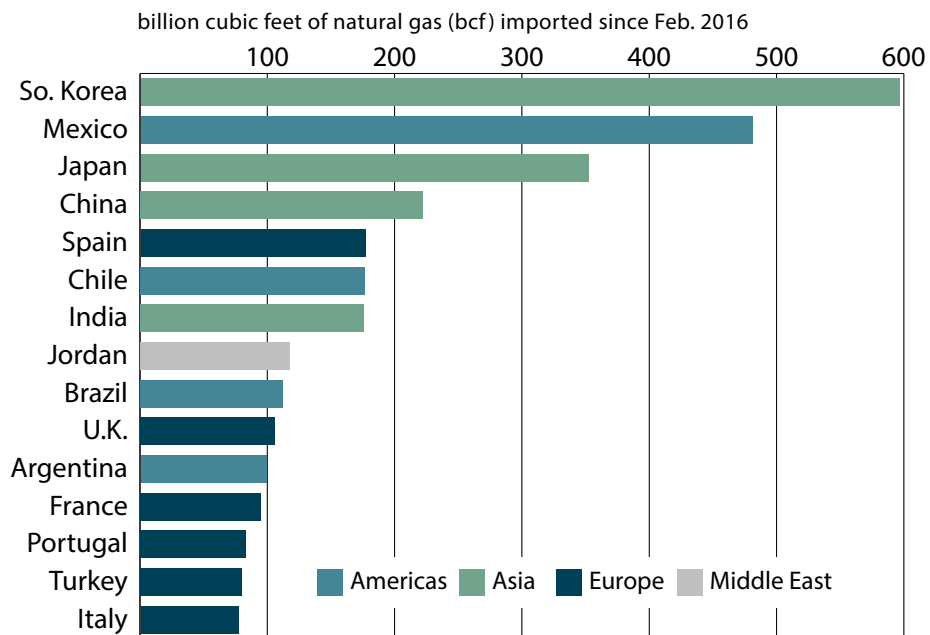
Regional Distribution of U.S. LNG - Past 12 Months
