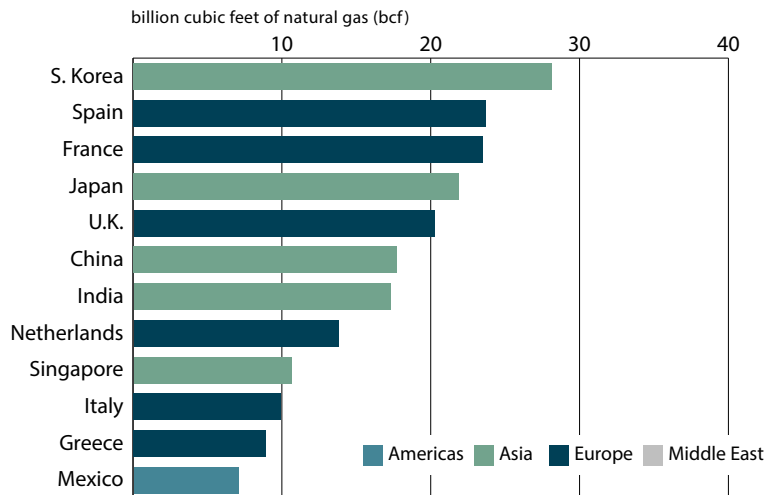


USLNG Exports: March 2020

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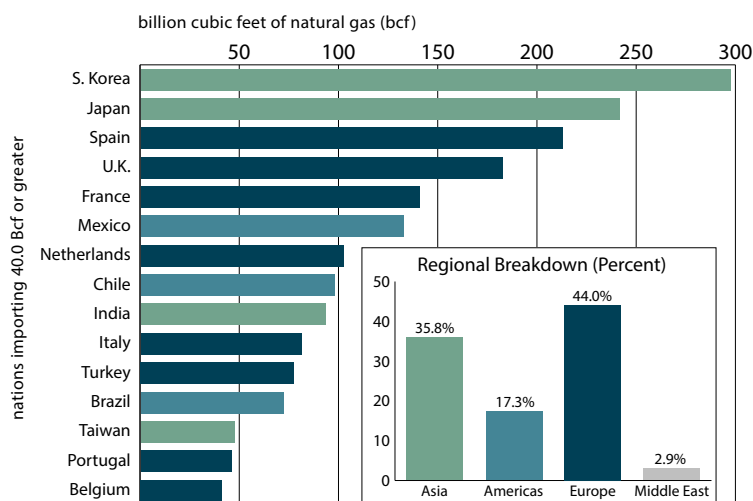
MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (MARCH)

- USLNG volumes increased in March versus Feb. 2020 and nearly equalled the record set in Jan. 2020. Shipments to China resumed after 11 month hiatus. Europe remains top region followed closely by Asia.

- Spain, 23.7 bcf

- Japan, 21.8 bcf
- U.K., 20.2 bcf

- Americas, 20.9 bcf (8.6%)
- Asia, 106.3 bcf (43.5%)
- Europe, 113.7 bcf (46.6%)
- Middle East, 3.2 bcf (1.3%)

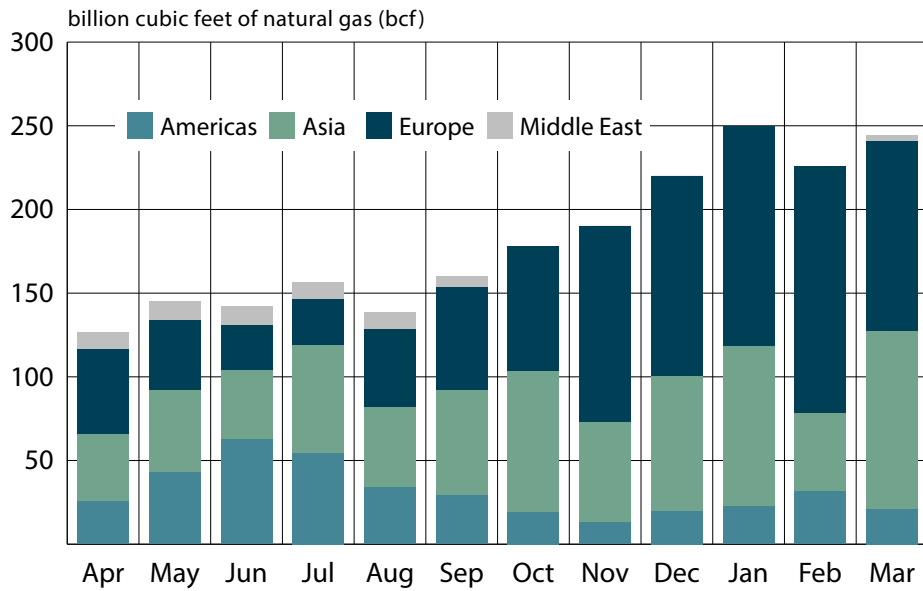
VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- Total exports of 244.1 bcf
- 8.2% more than Feb. 2020
- 86.7% more than March 2019

- 0 - Elba Island (unchanged)

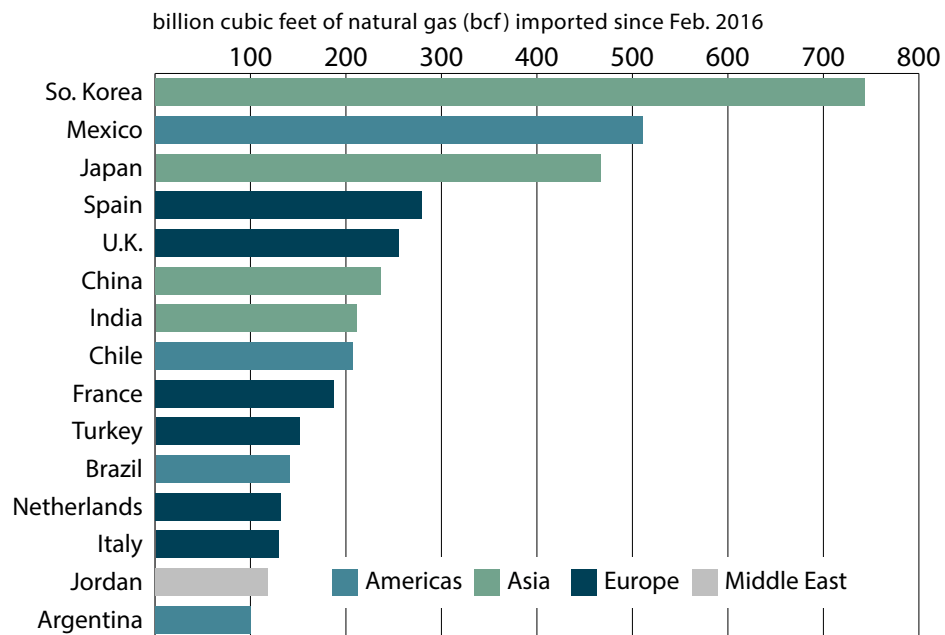
Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months

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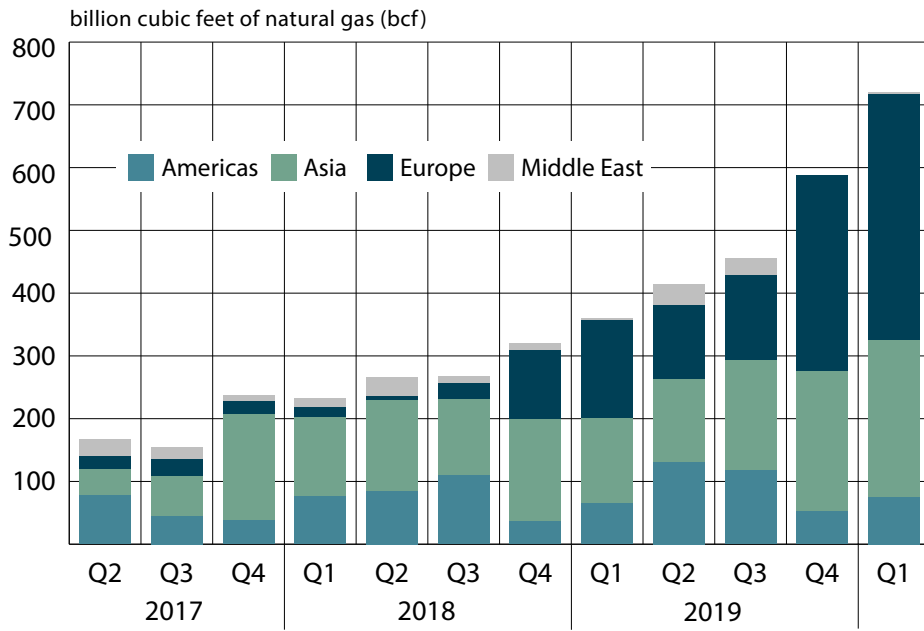
Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
