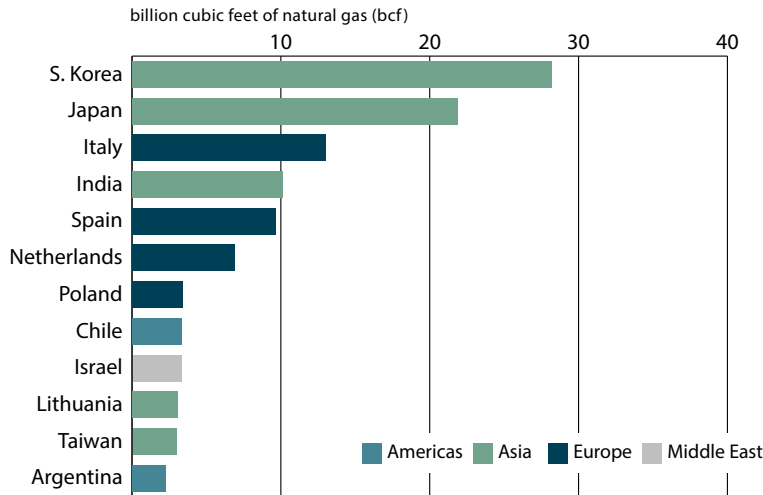


USLNG Exports: June 2020

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MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (JUNE)

- USLNG production continued to fall in June as a result of global market conditions. Almost 60 percent of cargoes went to Asia.

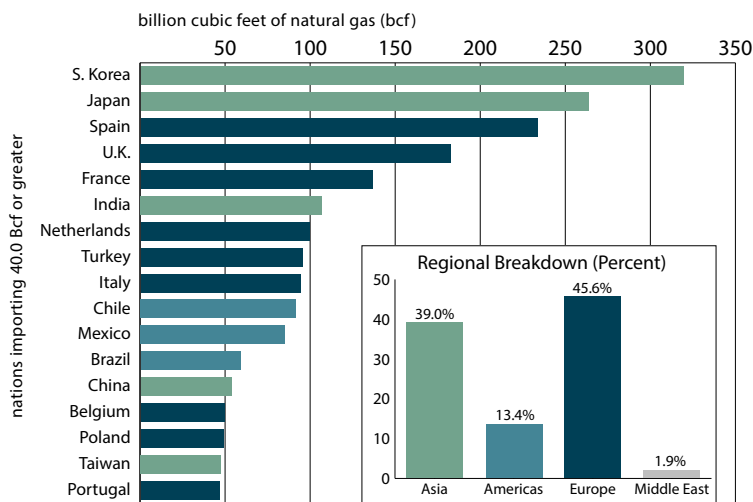
TOP DESTINATIONS (JUNE)

- S. Korea, 28.2 bcf
- Japan, 21.8 bcf
- Italy, 13.0 bcf
- India, 10.1 bcf
- Spain, 9.6 bcf
- Other destinations: Netherlands, Poland, Chile, Israel, Lithuania, Taiwan, Argentina

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN (JUNE)

- Americas, 5.5 bcf (5.1%)
- Asia, 63.1 bcf (58.5%)
- Europe, 35.9 bcf (33.3%)
- Middle East, 3.3 bcf (3.0%)

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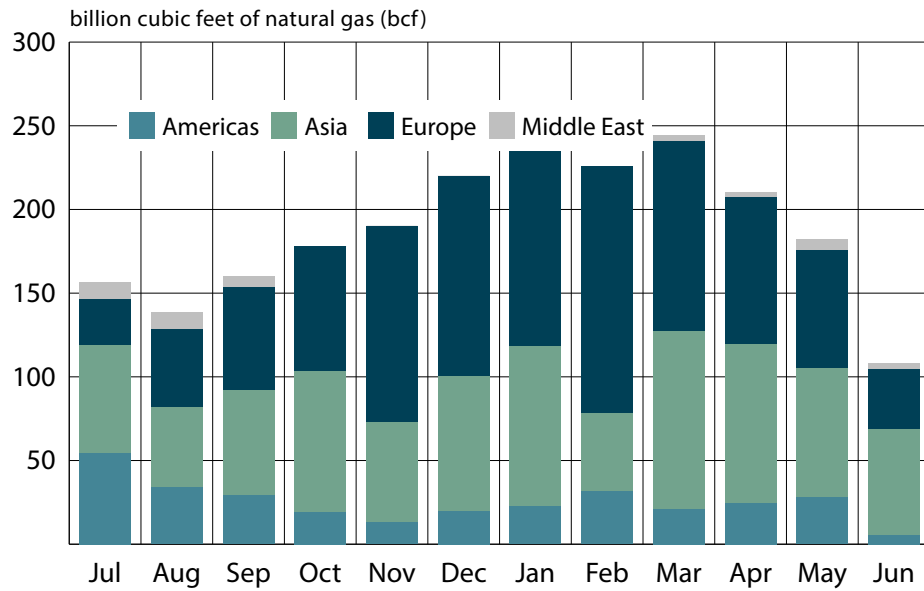
VOLUME EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- Total exports of 108.9 bcf
- 40.2% less than May 2020
- 23.2% less than June 2019

CARGOES EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- 34 Cargoes (-23 from May) 5 Terminals
- 12 - Cameron (+2 from May)
- 8 - Sabine Pass (-17 from May)
- 7 - Cove Point (+1 from May)
- 4 - Freeport (-4 from May)
- 3 - Corpus Christi (-5 from May)
- 0 - Elba Island (unchanged)

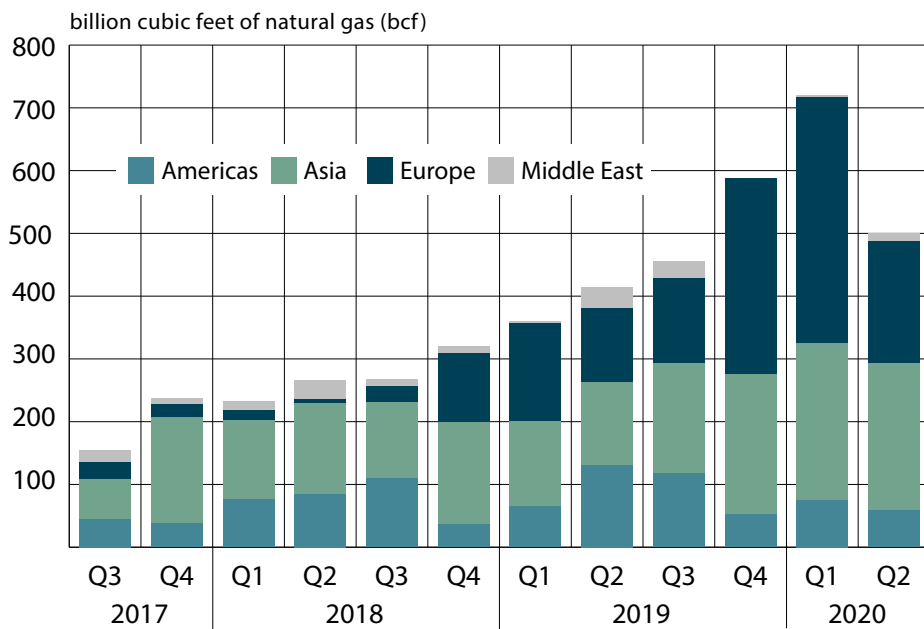
Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
